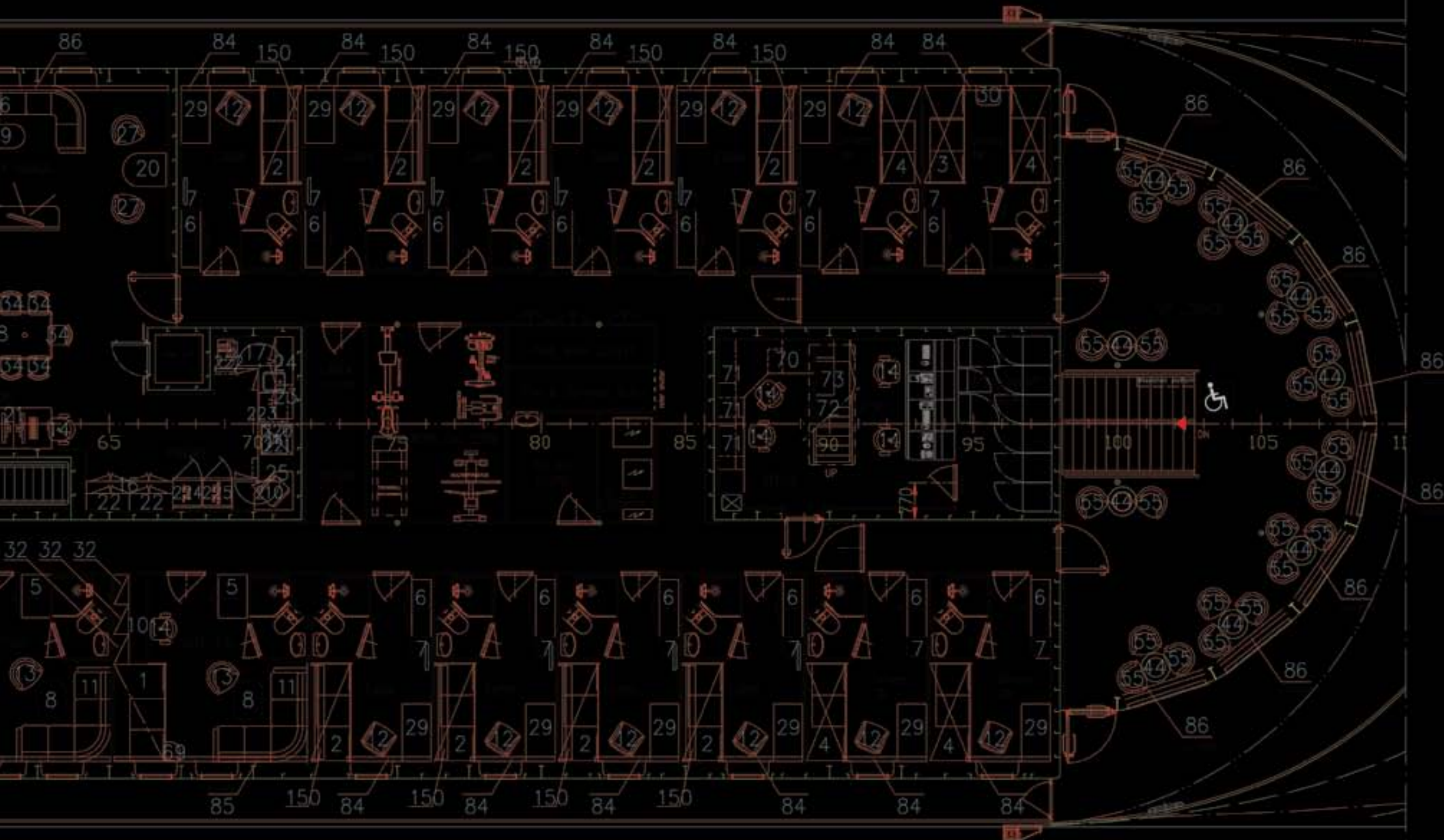

WHAT WE DO

The ACTIV Sp. z o.o. [Co. Ltd], established in late 90's – is connected with marine interior outfitting work, including f.eg.: ceiling and wall panels assembly; marine furniture supplies (incl. its removal/assembly); mounting of galley equipment; insulation and metal plating of pipes systems, cooled compartments and ventilation ducts.

The main site of ACTIV Sp z o.o. is localized abt. 30km from Gdansk.

Currently the company employs nearly 140 persons either in main factory next to the Head Office and in Outfitting Department located in Gdańsk, close to the shipyards area.

SCOPE OF ACTIVITY

The basic scope of work (however not limited to), that may be carried out by company ACTIV, on board of each type of seagoing vessels, offshore vessels, inland barges, tugboats, fishing vessels, etc. basically includes:

- o wall/ceiling insulation incl. fixing of pins
- o hotworks
- o assembly of floating floors
- o fixing of hot and cold waterpipes and it's isolation
- o marine furniture production
- o cable traces assembly
- o covering of surfaces and pipes with metal plates
- o assembly of wall and ceiling panels
- o assembly of floor panels/covers
- o assembly of sanitary blocks including systems connections
- o assembly of furniture and interior fittings on board
- o assembly of metal furniture (excl. its production)
- o covering the outer surfaces with wooden floors

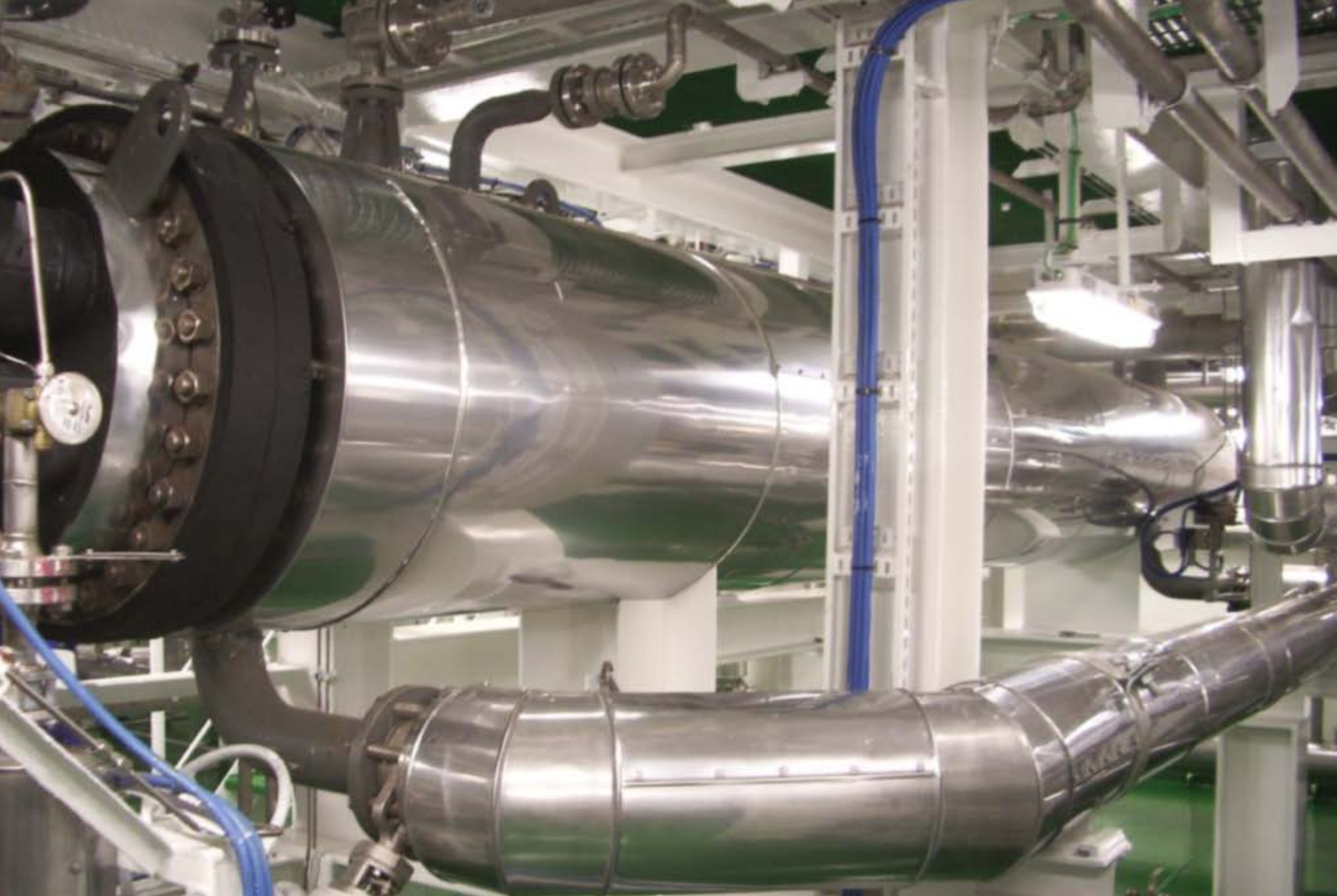

CABLE TRACES ASSEMBLY



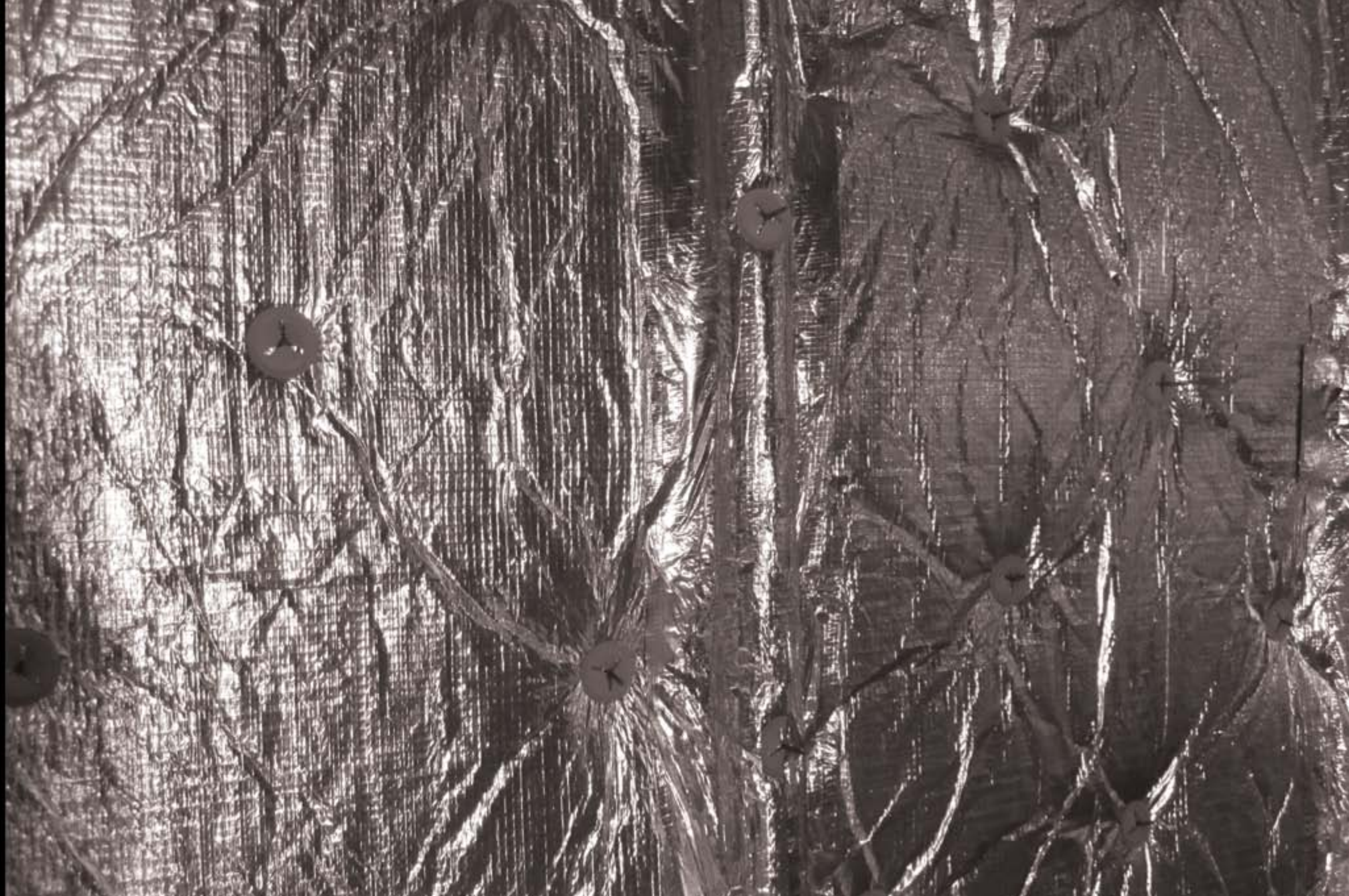


COVERING OF SURFACES AND PIPES WITH METAL PLATES

SCOPE OF ACTIVITY

We are also skilled with metal plating of low temperature piping systems on board of LPG/LNG gas carriers. Recently such scope of work has been executed on-board of LPG/LNG carrier, mv "Coral Methane", built in Stocznia Północna (Northern Shipyard) in Gdańsk, Poland. The company ACTIV is ready to execute wide scope of repairs work, modifications or conversions, which can be done on board of each type of vessel, during its staying at harbor or (where it is possible and necessary) such work could be executed onboard the vessels, during the short range sails between nearest harbors.

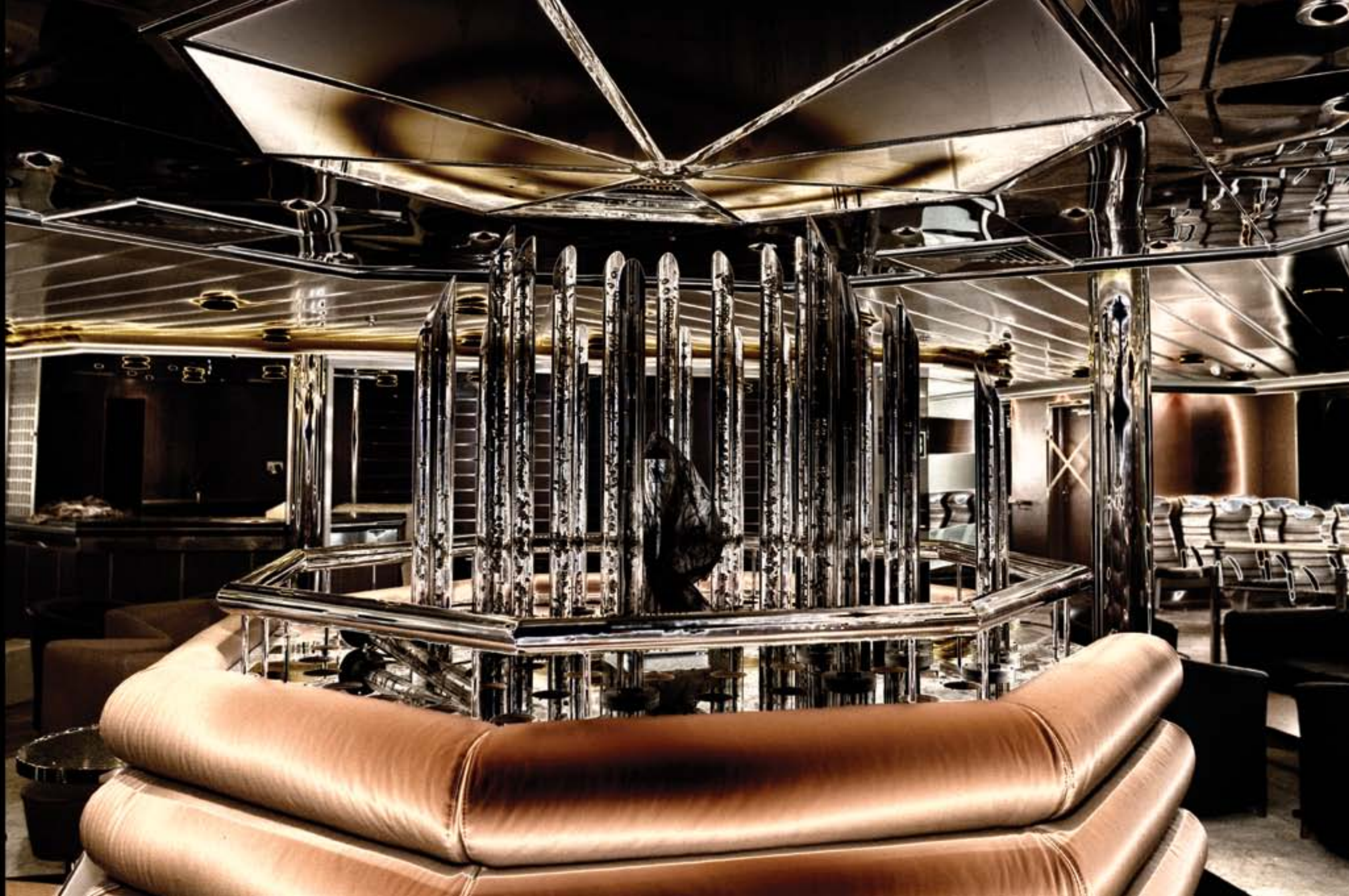
